

China Pre-Assessment Questions

Read through the following list of questions that are presented in a flow chart manner. After completing this pre-assessment, you and your spouse will learn if you meet the requirements for adoption through China's program. Please keep in mind, this assessment is only accurate based on the current information you provide. If any information you provide today were to change at any time during your adoption process, the CCAA may deny your application.

1. Are you married? Y/N
 - a. If yes - move on to #2.
 - b. If no - STOP, you do not qualify.
2. How long have you been married to your current spouse? _____
 - a. More than 2 years move on to #3.
 - b. Less than 2 years – STOP, you do not qualify.
3. Have you or your spouse ever been previously married? Y/N
 - a. If no – move on to # 4.
 - b. If yes, how many times? _____
 - i. If less than two marriages per couple and married 5 or more years – move on to #4.
 - ii. If more than 2 marriages per couple – STOP, you do not qualify.
 - iii. If less than two marriages per couple and not married 5 years – STOP, you do not qualify.
4. Are both you and your spouse between the ages of 30 and 49 years old? Y/N
 - a. If yes – move on to #5.
 - b. If no - STOP, you do not qualify (unless you adopt through special needs only, then you may proceed if you are under age 54.)
5. Can a medical doctor attest to the following conditions for you and your spouse:
 - a. You currently have no major physical or mental health diagnosis. Y/N
 - b. You have been free from any medication prescribed for mild depression and/or anxiety for **at least** 2 years. Y/N
 - c. You have a Body Mass Index of 40 or less. Y/N

- i. If you have circled all Yes's – move on to D.
 - ii. If you have ANY No's - STOP, you do not qualify.
 - d. In the past 10 years, have you had surgery on a major organ/s that would reduce your life expectancy. Y/N
 - i. If No – move on to #6.
 - ii. If Yes - STOP, you do not qualify.
- 6. Do you and/or your spouse hold a stable job? Y/N
 - a. If yes – move on to #7.
 - b. If no - STOP, you do not qualify.
- 7. Does your annual income total at least \$10,000.00 per person in the home including the prospective adoptee? (This annual income CANNOT include any of the following: Welfare subsidy, relief fund, pension, unemployment insurance, or any other form of government subsidy.) Y/N
 - a. If yes – move on to #8.
 - b. If no - STOP, you do not qualify.
- 8. Does your family have a net worth of at least \$80,000? Y/N
 - a. If yes – move on to #9.
 - b. If no - STOP, you do not qualify.
- 9. Do you and your spouse both have a high school diploma, GED or vocational skills training of the same level? Y/N
 - a. If yes – move on to #10.
 - b. If no - STOP, you do not qualify.
- 10. Are you and your spouse interested in adopting **only** a special needs child? Y/N
 - a. If yes – proceed to #13.
 - b. If no – proceed to #11.
- 11. Number of children under the age 18 living in the home? _____
 - a. If none – move on to #13.
 - b. If 4 or less – move on to #12.
 - c. If more than 4 – Stop, you do not qualify.
- 12. Is the youngest child in your home at least 1 year old? Y/N
 - a. If yes – move on to #13.
 - b. If no - STOP, you do not qualify.

13. Do you and/or your husband have a history of drug or alcohol abuse within the past 10 years? Y/N
- a. If no – move on to #14.
 - b. If yes - STOP, you do not qualify.
14. Do you and/or your spouse have a history of any of the following: domestic violence, perpetrator of sexual abuse, abandonment or abuse of a child (even if you weren't consequently arrested or criminated?) Y/N
- a. If no – move on to #15.
 - b. If yes - STOP, you do not qualify.
15. Have you or your spouse ever been charged or convicted of any other crime? Y/N
- a. If no – move on to #17.
 - b. If yes – move on to #16.
16. Have there been less than 3 of these charges or convictions? Y/N
- a. If yes – move on to #17.
 - b. If no – Stop, you do not qualify.
17. Have these charges or convictions been of slight severity with no severe outcomes and completion of restitution was at least 10 years ago? Y/N
- a. If yes – move on to #18.
 - b. If no – This does not automatically disqualify you, however additional documentation will be needed. *
18. Do you and your spouse have less than 5 individual traffic law violations with no severe outcomes? Y/N
- a. If yes – You would qualify to apply to adopt based on the information you have given.
 - b. If no - This does not automatically disqualify you, however additional documentation will be needed. *

*For these specific violations with the law, the CCAA has stated they would look at each case on an individual basis. CASI cannot guarantee you would receive approval.
